

Breeders to Stage Largest Stock Show

At the 37th International Live Stock Exposition, November 23 to December 5, leading stockmen and farmers of North America will join those of distant lands in staging the largest exhibition of purebred herds, prime market animals, and farm crops ever seen in the United States.

The exposition will be held at the Chicago Stock Yards in the new amphitheater and pens completed less than two years ago as a permanent home for the show.

Numerous High Lights
Its main arena, surrounded by 7500 seats, will be the setting for such headline events in agricultural affairs as the selection of the International grand champion steer; the naming of the winners in the various breeds of beef cattle and draft horses that represent the source of improvement for the major part of America's beef supply and its farm power.

The Junior Live Stock Feeding contest, in which hundreds of farm boys and girls exhibit their prize winning stock from county and state fair competitions; the Junior Live Stock Judging contest, in which students from a score of agricultural colleges take part.

And as a daily climax, the famous International Horse shows. In these events the continent's best saddle and harness horses, riding and driving ponies, and hunters and jumpers will be seen in contest for the top ribbons.

Mrs. Lee was Kitty Miller, niece of Zack Miller, founder of the Miller 101 ranch, at the time of her marriage to Powder River Jack. They have traveled together in western shows and Kitty Lee was teamed with Annie Oakley, famous woman gun expert.

Theodore Joelin, secretary to former President Hoover during his administration, is a very close friend of the couple and their many acquaintances include governors of many states and important persons in business and social circles.

They were guests of the Rosses from Saturday until Tuesday and during that time many friends called at the Ross home to meet the visitors and listen to the songs and romances of Powder River Jack, collected during his colorful career.

Neither Mr. or Mrs. Lee can be rated as professional entertainers, although their ability to enthrall their listeners has placed them in great demand. Powder River, as Mr. Lee prefers to be called, has written and collected many old ballads of the cowpunchers of the west. These he has put in book form.

He is an entirely different figure than represented in fiction. A tall six-footer, well built with a tanned skin, he stands erect and carries his years gracefully. His wavy silver hair accentuates his bearing. He dresses quietly in short boots, buckskin shirt and whipcord pants stuffed into his boots.
