MAYBE WE ARE JUST A POOR LOSER

MAYBE WE ARE JUST A POOR LOSER Yes, we admit it, we were surprised, in fact amazed at the tremendous majority, principally in the big cities. The Digest poll was right as far as it went but did not go nearly far enough. It revealed a large percentage of republican voters who voted democratic four years ago swinging back to the G.O.P. column. The results of the popular vote tabulation prove it. Landon's popular total was much greater than Hoover's of four years ago. The fact is that nearly all of those millions of new votes cast were democratic. They included the large majority of beneficiaries and relatives of beneficiaries of W.P.A., A.A.A., P.W.A., C.C.C. and H.O.L.C. They also included unskilled workers influenced by some of the leaders of the labor unions. We do not believe that all organized labor voted democratic. Many men in the higher skilled labor brackets voted as their own judgment dictated whether it was democratic or republican.
