Bronchos Take Wauconda 28-21; Ponies Win 17 to 15 Friday

The BIS Bronchos won their first conference game of the season by defeating the Wauconda quint 28 to 21 at Wauconda Friday night. The local Ponies succeeded in dumping the Wauconda quint by a 17 to 15 score in a very tight game the same evening.
