

Bronchos Lose Season's Final Grid Opener to Libertyville 7 to 26

Loss Marks Fifth Straight Defeat in Poor Campaign

Clinge Scores Lone Touchdown for Locals in Third Quarter

Revengeing their last year's defeat the Libertyville Wildcats unveiled their offensive football power and routed the Barrington Bronchos by a score of 26 to 7 on the Libertyville gridiron last Friday. The defeat was the Bronchos' fifth straight.

After a bad second quarter the Bronchos came back in the third period and after recovering a fumble on Libertyville's nine yard line, moved up to the four yard line where Clinge dodged a couple of Wildcat linemen who had broken through, and carried the ball over for the Bronchos' lone touchdown.

Daily Twice in Second
Sits came in for the Wildcat in the second quarter and Libertyville started clicking in its scoring march. Libertyville recovered Shepard's fumble on the four yard line and then Jaeger dropped back and completed a pass to Sits over the goal. May missed the kick for the extra point. The Wildcat again tallied when Jaeger plunged over on a reverse after Enevold returned a punt 60 yards before he was downed by Mountain on the two yard line. August then went over for the extra point on a play that baffled the Bronchos line. The ball was in the Bronchos' possession on their 20 yard line at the half.

Hodgdon was a surprised boy when he received the kickoff at the beginning of the second half. With the ball on the 49 yard line Thackeray picked up four yards and Shepard plunged eight yards for a first down. Then with fourth down and six yards to go Clinge booted down to the nine yard line where the Libertyville safety fumbled and Barrington recovered.

Thackeray gained five yards on the first play and the ball was great to Clinge who scored. Thackeray converted.

Thackeray kicked off and the Wildcat got the ball on the 30 yard line. Sits got off a 50 yard quick kick which brought the ball back to the Barrington 20 yard line. Nestlerode fumbled a pass from center and Libertyville recovered.

After two 15 yard penalties for holding charged against the Wildcat, Jaeger tried a pass which was intercepted by Johnson on the 17 yard line and he returned it to the 35 yard line. Nestlerode dropped back in punt formation on the fourth down and the pass from center was way over his head and a Libertyville man recovered on the seven yard line as the whistle blew for the end of the third quarter. Jaeger went over for a

touchdown on the first play in the fourth quarter. The place kick was blocked. In the fourth quarter after an exchange of kicks by Barrington and Libertyville respectively, August intercepted a pass intended for Rice. With the ball on the 34 yard line Sits picked 12 yards while Jaeger went through for 17 yards, bringing the ball up to Barrington's 7 yard line. Jaeger picked up three more yards and then Sits accounted for the last Wildcat touchdown. Getchell droppicked the extra point. The ball was on the Bronchos' 33 yard line at the close of the game.

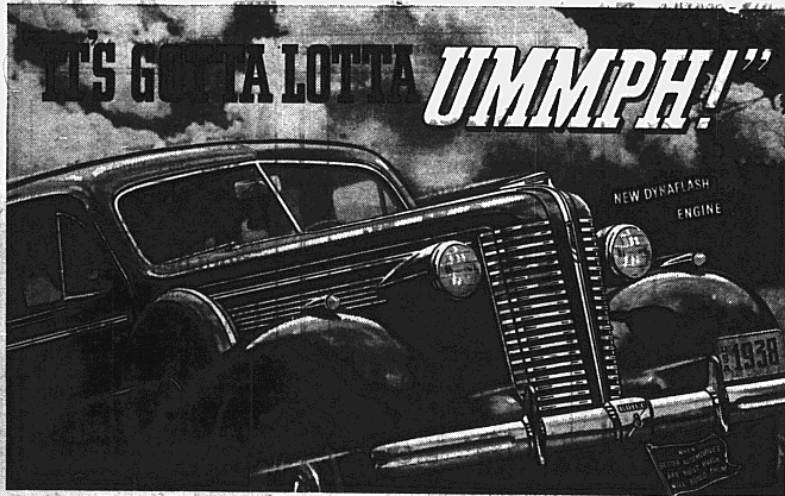
