REGULATIONS

WITH WHICH SUBSCRIBERS HAVE AGREED TO COMPLY

USE AND CARE OF EQUIPMENT. The Subscriber shall not make, permit, or use any electrical or mechanical connections, or apparatus with the lines, or equipment furnished by the Company, without the Company's consent. The lines and equipment on subscriber's premises shall be carefully protected, and used for lawful purposes where installed, and upon any termination of subscriber's contract shall be surrendered to the Company, unimpaired, except by reasonably careful use. At all reasonable times the Company shall have the right, which the subscriber shall provide, of access from the street line, and of entering the premises of the subscriber to install, inspect, or repair the lines or equipment, or to remove them upon the termination of the subscriber's right of use. The subscriber shall not use or permit the use of foul, abusive, or profane language, or persecute any other individual with fraudulent or malicious intent, over the equipment furnished.

THE COMPANY DOES NOT GUARANTEE UNINTERRUPTED WORKING OF THE LINES OR EQUIPMENT. For any complete failure of service, of which notice in writing has been sent to its general manager, and continued for more than twenty-four hours thereafter, an abatement of the contract charge for the period of such interruption shall be made.

Claims for rebate on account of interruption to service cannot be considered unless such written notice has been given to the Company.

The Company shall not be liable for defaults occurring on any other line, and the subscriber agrees to reimburse the Company for all sums it may pay, or become liable to pay, for messages transmitted for the subscriber over other lines than its own.

SUBSCRIBER'S NUMBER. The prefix and number assigned to a subscriber's station are no part of the contract with the Company, and may be changed by the Company when necessary. Numbers must be changed when required by the opening of new exchanges, or the regrouping of lines.

DIRECTORIES. The Company assumes no liability for damages arising from errors, or omissions, in the making up, or printing of the directory. Subscribers are requested, when they desire any change in their insertion, to notify the Company in writing.

PRIVATE BRANCH EXCHANGE OPERATION. Operators employed by the subscriber for the operation of private branch exchange switching apparatus, shall comply with the operating rules of the Telephone Company, and render service satisfactory to it.

COLLECTIONS. Settlements for service are due upon receipt of bills rendered about the first of each month. Payment should always be made before the 15th of each month at the Local Exchange Office. Checks should be made payable to the Chicago Telephone Company. When a subscriber is delinquent the Company may partially or entirely suspend service to or for the subscriber until payment and compliance with the retrenchment regulations.

ALTERATIONS. The subscriber agrees to notify the Company promptly in writing whenever alterations or new construction on premises owned or leased by him will necessitate changes in the Company's equipment, and the subscriber agrees to pay the Company's current charges for such changes.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR LOCATION. The Company will move the equipment to any point where the Company furnishes similar service, within the limits of the same exchange system accessible with its facilities, upon written order, when the subscriber agrees to pay the Company's current charge therefor. Such removal will be made without charge after the equipment has remained in the location for one year, but such removal without charge will constitute an express extension of the subscriber's contract for a period of one year from the completion of the removal. **AFTER A REMOVAL THE SUBSCRIBER SHALL PAY THE CURRENT RATE FOR SERVICE AT THE LOCATION TO WHICH THE REMOVAL IS MADE.**

TERMINATION. The subscriber or the Company may terminate the contract on terms stated therein at any time before the equipment has been in use one year at one address, or location, and may terminate after said year, by giving ten days' written notice, in which case the subscriber shall pay in full to the end of such ten days, and the Company will refund the portion of any payment made in advance unexpired at the end of such ten days.

GENERAL INFORMATION

AND INSTRUCTIONS TO TELEPHONE USERS

TELEPHONE NUMBERS. Each subscriber's telephone is designated by a number placed at the left of his name. It is imperative that subscribers call by number (not name) to avoid error and delay. Always use the current telephone directory to obtain the correct numbers.

THE INFORMATION OPERATOR WILL FURNISH on request **NUMBERS** of new subscribers **NOT LISTED** and who have had service installed after this directory was printed; or of numbers which have been changed.

HOW TO USE THE TELEPHONE. A local message is a communication not exceeding five minutes' duration between subscriber's stations within the same exchange area. To call the Exchange Office, take the hand telephone from the hook and place it to the ear. (If the telephone has a crank attachment for signaling Central, give two quick turns of the crank before removing the hand telephone from the hook.) The operator will say "Number, please?" Give the exchange name and number of the subscriber wanted, and the operator will repeat them to avoid mistakes. Remain with the telephone at the ear until an answer is received. If the desired line is busy the busy signal (an interrupted buzzing noise) or the operator will notify you of that fact. This means that the line called for is in use. Always hang up the hand telephone when through talking and if the telephone has a crank attachment, give two quick turns of the crank to notify the operator to disconnect.

HOW TO ANSWER A TELEPHONE CALL. Remove the hand telephone from the hook and give your own number, as for example, "This is Main 294" (or whatever the number may be). This will immediately inform the person calling that the desired connection has been established.

REPORT TROUBLE. When the line or instrument is out of order, notify the Manager or Chief Operator of your Exchange. If the trouble is not remedied within twenty-four hours, kindly send notice in writing to General Manager, Chicago Telephone Co., 230 W. Washington St., Chicago, Illinois.

A TOLL MESSAGE is a communication to a telephone beyond the limits of your local exchange system, but within the area in which the Company operates. A Long Distance Message is a communication to a telephone outside of the area in which the Company operates. The Company's employees must not undertake to transmit or deliver verbal or written messages for patrons.

Toll or Long Distance rates are for messages of three minutes or less. A charge is made for each additional minute or fraction thereof.

TO MAKE A TOLL OR LONG DISTANCE CALL. Call for "Long Distance" and when the Long Distance Operator answers, give the name of the town, and exchange name and number, when known, and the name and address, or the necessary information to identify the party desired. The operator will make the connection and will call you to the telephone.

TO MAKE COLLECT CALLS. Toll or Long Distance messages can be sent "collect" provided the person receiving a collect message agrees to allow the same to be charged to him. Request to have the charges made against the party called for should be made at the time the call is given to the Toll or Long Distance Operator.

ORDER TO MOVE TELEPHONE. If you wish to have telephone moved, please **FILL OUT** a move order and mail to **MANAGER** of your Exchange, or No. 230 W. Washington St., Chicago, at least ten days before date removal is desired.

NOTE. Thirty days' notice is necessary for removal between April 15th and May 15th.

Toll Service

Believing that our toll service adequately meets the demand for quick communication between telephone users in the various cities and villages near Chicago, we encourage our patrons to use the long distance lines.

Rates

Our information operator has a list of exchanges and will advise you of the rate of service to any point. We also call attention to the fact that we maintain a messenger service at each exchange and will call any party with whom you wish to talk, even though he has no telephone, providing you will pay a nominal charge for the messenger.
